# Dependency

Dependency is the fifth law of a High Impact Church. It was the theme when Jesus taught His disciples to pray "our Father". He did so to restore our distorted image of the Father. We have to become like little children to enter the Kingdom of God. That's where we want to be as a church – it's about the King and His Kingdom.

In the past, religious sentiment wanted to form a god-statue out of wood and stone. Unfortunately in these days many in Christendom have manufactured a god out of their own carnal minds. The lack of the fear of God in His church is proof of this. Our attitude of dependence is totally eclipsed by the drive to be successful. Where we need dependency most as God's children is in our attitude, action and aim.

Peter was a man who was impulsive and his self-confidence was exposed for all to see. When Peter rebuked Jesus after He had revealed to His disciples what would happen to Him in Jerusalem, Jesus' response was: "get behind me Satan, you are a stumbling block to me, you do not have in mind the things of God, but the things of men".

This same Peter who learned from this experience reminds his readers in 1 Peter 5:5-6 that humility – the attitude of dependency on God – is required of all of us: "Humble yourselves therefore under God's mighty hand that he may lift you up in due time".

If we have allowed God to deal with our attitude, the next area of testing will be in our action. In Luke 11, Jesus teaches us to pray – because praying faith links me with divinity. Faith clothes the dependent child with the power of the living God – our heavenly Father. Children do not grow weary of asking – and if our image of God is being restored, prayer is no longer a duty but a delight.

The aim of dependency is fruitfulness – if we abide in the vine we will bear fruit – so that He may receive all the glory due to His name.
