# BREAKING FREE

The cry for freedom is a deep desire in every human heart. It means different things to different people: to the bungee jumper it is the feeling of flying, to the oppressed, freedom from oppression. And yet, Paul can say "it is for freedom that Christ has set you free" (Gal 5:1).

In Germany, 1.3 million people abuse alcohol. For the alcoholic, freedom from pain is linked to the bottle. According to the UN, there are 200 million substance abusers worldwide. That which promised freedom has become the abuse of freedom. To many, freedom is perceived to be something easy and effortless – nothing could be further from the truth. Billions are paid for arms to keep America and other countries free. Without making an effort we will never experience true freedom - by putting freedom above discipline, we will lose both.

The Prodigal Son in Luke 15 asked for his freedom. He said, "Give me what is due to me". But he was a son so everything his father had was his anyway. It is our insistence on wanting to be free that expresses our lack of maturity, as well as our inability to use what God gives wisely. When we do not trust Him to give us what is best we have to learn the hard way. Without the Father's discipline we cannot develop and we will go back to being slaves, not sons: God disciplines those He loves.

We can only experience true freedom when we come into line with our Heavenly Father and His will and way: "If the Son therefore will make you free, you are free indeed" (John 8:36).
