PURE AND SPOTLESS BRIDE

The account in the first three chapters of Genesis gives a good picture of God. Holiness is revealed in His works at the beginning, He pronounced all that He made, "very good", which He could not have done if there was any imperfect or unholy thing.

We are made in His image, and can call Him 'Abba', but we need to see Him as holy, He is absolute purity. "God is light, and in him is no darkness at all" (1 John 1:5). The prophet Habakkuk cries out: "Thou art of purer eyes than to behold evil, and canst not look on iniquity" (Hab 1:1).

He deserves our reverence. "Who will not fear you, O Lord and bring glory to your name, for you alone are holy" (Rev 15:4). This perfection is celebrated before the throne of heaven. The seraphim cry: "Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord of hosts" (Is 6:3).

In John 17, the Lord Jesus prayed in His high priestly prayer that we be sanctified or purified by His truth and that we should not be taken out of the world.

In ancient times the royal bride would go through lengthy preparation for the marriage feast (Esther 2:12). In Ephesians 5, Paul describes the Bride being washed from any spot or wrinkle: purged from all pollution and dominion of sin, of backsliding and double-mindedness. When we are filled with the Holy Spirit, submitted to His will, He applies the truth to our hearts and we will be transformed into His likeness.

There is nothing more needed today than that His church will seek His washing and cleansing. God alone is the source of holiness – He alone is able to sanctify us. "Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy" (Jude 1:24).
